We're delighted that Dantastic Productions and our very own pantomime comic, Dan Whitley, are back to entertain us as part of our half term kids programme which also includes *Curious Investigators*, *Dracula the Panto* and *The Magic* of Science.

Our magical Christmas season starts with *Santa's Christmas Cracker* followed by the return of Let's All Dance Ballet Company performing *The Nutcracker*.
